Network Building

LSICA Direct Grants to State Arts Agencies

- \$60,000 tier (17 awards) and \$23,000 tier (19 awards)
- All 56 state and jurisdictional arts agencies invited to apply
- 36 applied and received funding
- Trust-based philanthropy principles

 - Grant administration
 - Reporting requirements
