Organizations & individuals may apply. Receive up to \$1,500 for new community events of all disciplines that include the arts.




Professional Development



Community Arts Access

Arts & non-arts organizations may apply. Receive up to \$3,000 for arts activities or programming in ND communities.



- 1) Folk & Traditional Arts Apprenticeship Participants receive up to \$4,000 for master and traditional artist(s) to pass on skills & knowledge to new artist(s) over an extended period of time.
- 2) Individual Artist Fellowship Two \$5,000 fellowships are awarded to established individual artists in eligible disciplines that rotate every 3 years.
- 3) Featured Artist at the Capitol ND artists may apply to be featured in the exhibit space on the 18th, or observatory floor, of the ND State Capitol.
- 4) Arts Across the Prairie

A program creating eight large-scale art installations - one for each geographic region in the state - that reflect the unique history, landscape, & cultural heritage of each region.
